Option 2: One 6-foot space, including (if requested) 2 chairs and a 6-foot banquet table (\$50).

All special requests **MUST** be made prior to May 1, 2023. If you require more space than one 8- or 6-foot space size, you must reserve two spaces.

Allowed Vendors: Any vendor taking part in the Strathmore Baby & Tot Show must have products either supplied by vendor, or created by vendor and must all be directed at maternity, infant or children.

Table is **NOT** reserved until the organizers receive your table fee.

If you intend to register, be sure to register **ASAP**, as we are limiting the space to one vendor per similar category (i.e., one specific MLM company).

Your table will be labeled, so please look for your name upon arrival.

CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

Table setup will begin at 8am, May 13, 2023. Please complete setup prior to doors opening at 10am. Early departure is strictly prohibited. Tear down begins at 4pm.

Clean up of your area is your responsibility. Do not leave any garbage behind.

1. Subletting of space by the exhibitor is prohibited. Sharing or other use of the space not specifically authorized prior to the Show by the Organizers is prohibited.
2. No signs or advertising devices shall be displayed outside space other than those furnished by the Organizers. Displays blocking the unobstructed view from space to space are prohibited. If display is more than 36" high, such higher section of display can only extend four feet outwards along the side rails. No displays or signs may be affixed to building walls or posts.
3. No wiring, installation of spotlights or other electrical work and no carpentry work shall be done except by either Centre employees or firms so designated by the Organizers.
4. Exhibitors shall abide by and observe all laws, rules and regulations of the Province and Town of Strathmore where the Show takes place, and departments thereof and all rules of the related Centre.
5. No exhibitor shall use any inflammable decorations or covering for display fixtures and all fabrics or other material used for decoration or covering of tables should be flameproof.
6. **Once a contract is accepted, Exhibitors shall not be entitled to a refund of any part of any fee should the exhibitor for any reason be unable to exhibit and the show, or cancel any space previously contracted for. Exhibitors who are unable to exhibit at the show or cancel any space previously contracted for, will have funds donated to the non-profit organization sponsored by the Show.**
7. If an exhibitor fails to make payments due herein when they are due, such exhibitors rights to exhibit may be cancelled by the Organizers without further notice.
8. Organizers reserve the right to alter or change the space assigned to an exhibitor, or alter or remove exhibits of any part thereof, including printed material, product, signs, lights or sound, and to expel exhibitors or their personnel if, in Organizers opinion, their conduct or presentation is objectionable to other Show Participants.
9. Organizers reserve the right to cancel this contract and to withhold possession of exhibit space at Organizer's discretion, and/or if the Exhibitor fails to perform any material condition of the contract or refuses to abide by Show rules and regulations.
10. In the event that because of war, fire, strike, government regulation, public catastrophe, act of God or the public enemy or other cause, the Show or any part thereof is prevented from being held, if canceled by the Organizers the exhibit space applied for herein becomes unavailable, the Organizers shall determine and refund the applicant his proportionate share of the balance of the aggregate exhibit fees received, which remains after deducting expenses incurred by the Organizers and reasonable compensation to the Organizers, but in no case shall the amount of refund to the applicant exceed the amount of the Exhibit fee paid.
11. Neither the Organizers, the Centre or any of their officers, agents, employees or other representatives shall be held accountable or liable for, and the same are hereby released from accountability or liability for any damage, loss, harm or injury to the person or any other representatives, resulting from theft, fire, water, accident or any other cause, and neither the Organizers or the Centre will obtain insurance against any such damage, loss, harm or injury.
12. The applicant hereby agrees to indemnify, defend and protect the Organizers and the Centre against, and hold and save the Organizers and the Centre harmless from any and all claims, demands, suits, liability, damages, loss, costs, attorney fees and expense of whatever kind or natures which might result from or arise out of any action or failure to act of the applicant or any of its officers, agents, employees or other representatives, including but not limited to claims or damage or loss to property or from or out of any damage, loss, harm or injury to the person or any property of the applicant of any of its officers, agents, employees or other representatives.
